Maplewood Chapel Mausoleum Rules and Regulations

In order to preserve the solemnity and beauty of your mausoleum, it is necessary that the following rules and regulations be observed:

- 1) Visiting hours are from *sun up* until *sun down* every day of the year *weather permitting*. *During inclement weather the cemetery is closed to all visitors*.
- 2) Crypt and Niche *owners* may *place cards etc*. on *memorial trees only* which are located inside the mausoleum. Items will be removed several times per year to prevent clutter and/or prior to an entombment.
- 3) Items removed from memorial trees will be kept in the office for a period of time if you wish to claim them, otherwise they will be discarded.
- 4) Nothing other than what is provided by the floral service is permitted in the vases attached to the crypt or niche fronts. Anything else will be removed and discarded. *All vase purchases must accompany a vase service contract agreement prior to installation.*
- 5) At *no time* should any *decoration* be *taped* or *adhered* in any fashion *to* the surface of the *crypt* or *niche* fronts. Anything found attached to the surface will be removed and discarded.
- 6) *Fresh flowers, potted plants, silk floral arrangements, vigil candles, etc.* are *not permitted* in the chapel or terrace areas of the mausoleum. Anything found will be removed and discarded. *Only decorations* that are *provided by the floral service are permitted* with the exception of items placed on memorial trees. No planting of any kind permitted around mausoleum grounds.
- 7) Smoking, eating, drinking as well as pets are not permitted in the chapel of the mausoleum or anywhere around the mausoleum areas of the cemetery.
- 8) *All lettering* for crypts and niches along with any ornamentation *will be determined by the cemetery company*. Chapel crypts will be allowed bronze lettering and emblems. A middle initial will be permitted provided spacing is available. Terrace crypts and niches will be allowed engraved lettering and emblems. All crypts and niches will be allowed bronze vases which style and sizes will be determined, sold and installed by Maplewood Cemetery Company. All crypts and niches will also be allowed cameo photographs that will be sold, supplied and installed by Maplewood Cemetery Company. Two sizes will be available, one bronze framed for the crypts and one with no frame for the niches.
- 9) If a body is disentembed from the mausoleum for any reason, the family or responsible person(s) is responsible for replacing the crypt front. (See price list for applicable cost). Even if they decide not to entomb another person, or sell the crypt, the crypt front must be replaced at the owner's expense.

It is the desire of Maplewood Cemetery Company to maintain the cemetery and mausoleum to the highest of standards possible. It is with this idea in mind that we have established the foregoing rules and regulations. These rules and regulations are subject to change as is found necessary by Maplewood Cemetery Company.
